Thank you for contacting me with your concerns about environmental clean-up and the final disposition of the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL) site.

Clean-up of this site is a high public health and safety priority. I am working to ensure that Congress appropriates the necessary funding for the Department of Energy and National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA). I have also been meeting with the responsible federal agencies to ensure that they are aware of the community concerns.

I also share your concern for the future of the SSFL site. I am hopeful that the public process for disposition of this site will result in a final outcome that is supported by the local community and protects the important historic and cultural aspects of this site. I am encouraged that the National Park Service and Bureau of Indian Affairs are talking with interested community partners about the future of the SSFL site, and I will continue to insist that the federal agencies involved in this process work with the community.

As the process moves forward, I hope that you will continue to reach out to express your viewpoint.
